DAY 4	MATTHEW 5:1-12 What are the practices or routines that keep your soul at peace and generate a gentle, forgiving spirit in you?
DAY 5	MATTHEW 5:1-12 What would forgiveness, restoration, and renewal look like in your community- your family, neighbors, schools, businesses, and restaurants in your city or town?
DAY 6	MATTHEW 5:1-12 Reflect on whether there is someone from whom you are withholding mercy, seeing only their sin or offense. What good do you see or have you seen in that person and what would a generous extension of mercy toward them look like?
DAY 7	MATTHEW 5:1-12 Where do you see inconsistencies between what you present to the world and what is actually going on in your heart?
DAY 8	MATTHEW 5:1-12 When you think of a lack of peace in the world today, what comes to mind and how might you be a peacemaker in that area?
DAY 9	MATTHEW 5:1-12 What comes to mind when you think of people consistently doing the right thing even when it's difficult?
DAY 10	MATTHEW 5:1-12 In what ways have you insulated yourself or compartmentalized your faith in Jesus in order to avoid persecution or ridicule?
