Once you had no identity as a people; now you are God's people. Once you received no mercy; now you have received God's mercy. 1 PE T E R 2 : 9 -1 0 , nlt

According to this passage, you are: Chosen Royal A Priest A Holy Nation God's Special Possession Out of Darkness In Wonderful Light God's People Recipient of Mercy

These God-given names are not for you or me to simply hold close and keep to ourselves. These names are far bigger than that: They are a God-given calling to show others the goodness of God (1 Peter 2:9).

That is what it means to be a royal priest.
